Endesa Ireland welcomes the opportunity to respond to the Consultation Paper on the 2011/12 Contracting Process, including PSO-related CfDs.

Endesa Ireland is in favour of the proposal to increase the regularity of PSO-related CfD offerings, so that half would be offered monthly and half quarterly. Endesa Ireland is disappointed that the RAs did not proceed with the proposal to offer DCs on a quarterly basis, as decided in SEM-11-17, particularly given that most of those responding to the consultation were in favour of the proposal.
