Market Coupling Governance Guideline

- EC published consultation on a governance framework for market coupling November 2011
- Aim of creating adequate and harmonised governance structures for power exchanges and relationship with TSOs
- Four options for Legally Binding Governance Framework
 - 1. No action
 - 2. Local diversity allowed
 - 3. High levels of harmonisation
 - 4. New centralised regulated entity to perform market coupling





Market Coupling Governance Guideline

- Other provisions:
 - Members States designation of PX
 - Regional extension
 - Costs and financing
- May be extended to Intra Day or separate Intra Day guideline
- Comments by 29 February 2012. ACER are submitting a joint response to the Commission



- Currently being drafted by ENTSO-E for consultation
- ACER are monitoring progress
- ENTSO-E will submit NC CACM to ACER for its approval
- NC CACM will include transitional arrangements for island systems with central dispatch
- Due to enter into force from end 2013
- Separate NC for Forward Market





Forward Target Model

- ▶ ENSTO- E to begin drafting Forward NC in Q4 2012
- ACER Task Force established to coordinate progress
- Key Issues:
 - Harmonisation of auction rules
 - Harmonisation of allocation platform
 - Physical or Financial Transmission Rights
- 2 ACER consultations planned in 2012:
 - 1. Proposal for harmonised set of auction rules based on CWE
 - 2. Possible implementation of FTRs





Electricity Balancing FG

- FGs being developed by ACER
- RAs are represented on drafting team
- Will form part of Target Model
- Approval February 2012
- Public consultation: March/April 2012



- FUI Ministries and RAs meetings take place in February
- FUI SG planned for April in Belfast to focus on SEM Market Integration Paper
- FUI to consider long term target model
- NWE Day Ahead and Intra Day projects ongoing: intra day interim 2012, enduring 2014
- ▶ EIP, NSOGI regional role in identifying PCIs
