
Fingleton White welcomes the opportunity to respond to the CER and UREGNI consultation document regarding the Integrated Single Electricity Market (I-SEM) High Level Design for Ireland and Northern Ireland from 2016, and the opportunity to submit comments.

Fingleton White operates a number of Combined Heat and Power (CHP) sites and hydro sites throughout Ireland.

We do not have sufficient knowledge to answer the forty-two consultation questions because in most cases they will not affect us. This is because the de-minimus level is 10MW. We suggest that this level is not reduced for the Integrated Single Electricity Market (I-SEM).
