Local Market Power

Opportunities to Exercise Market Power under the SEM design

- Where transmission constraints exist, generators may be able to benefit from local market power
- Where a generator is constrained on, it can benefit by raising its offer prices, as the TSO often has to dispatch them, irrespective of the merit order
- Where a generator is constrained off, it can benefit from reducing its offer price, as it retains any difference between SMP and its offer price (i.e. inframarginal rent)

Local Market Power Mitigation in SEM

- Some of the measures put in place to mitigate market power in general will also mitigate local market power e.g.:
 - Bidding principles (licence condition and BCOP)
 - Market monitoring
- The Grid Code also prevents the withholding of capacity

Local Market Power in I-SEM

- Market Power Workstream will consider market power across the market timeframes
- Therefore the issue of local market power is best considered there
- Are there specific issues that should be considered in relation to the BM design in relation to market power.
